Amazing Love

"See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" 1 John 3:1.

" 'My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me' " John 17:20-21.



Practical Love

* Serve one another

"You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love" Galatians 5:13 (Matthew 20:25-28).

* Encourage one another

"...encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing" 1 Thessalonians 5:11.

* Minister to one another

"Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work" Ephesians 4:15-16 (Colossians 3:14-17).
